Main conditions:

- 1.** Only those applicants, who completed higher legal education in law and/or hold a postgraduate degree in law are eligible to take part in the competition.
- 2.** The authors should address any subject within the editorial policy of the DLJ and conduct comparative research on digital law in the Russian and foreign legal systems.
- 3.** The research papers can be submitted either in Russian or in English.
- 4.** Submission timeline:
 - The applicants should submit a brief CV and an abstract not exceeding 500 words with the proposed title of research paper by January 15, 2022;
 - The full text of the papers are expected to be received by April 15, 2022.
