Main conditions:

1. Only those applicants, who completed higher legal education in law and/or hold a postgraduate degree in law are eligible to take part in the competition.

2. The authors should address any subject within the editorial policy of the DLJ and conduct comparative research on digital law in the Russian and foreign legal systems.

- **3.** The research papers can be submitted either in Russian or in English.

- The applicants should submit a brief CV and an abstract not exceeding 500 words with the proposed title of research paper by January 15, 2022;
- The full text of the papers are expected to be received by April 15, 2022.
